This college was established as a Girls' High School on October 30, 1996, initiated by the then Divisional Commissioner of Allahabad Division, Mr. Deshdeepak Verma, IAS, through the foundation stone laying and his inspiration. The school, which was born as a Girls' High School, became an esteemed intermediate college in the city within just two years, offering various subjects in Humanities and Science streams. To fulfill the city's demands and aspirations, in 2005, the Honorable Governor authorized teaching in seven subjects (Hindi, Sanskrit, English, ancient History, History, Socio Sociology, Education, Political Science), and the B.A. curriculum was affiliated by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad. In July 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education, North Central Region, Jaipur, granted permission for the B.Ed. program. In 2011, teaching authorization was extended to three additional subjects (Geography, Music Vocal, Home Science), and in 2013, two more subjects (Urdu, Physical Education) were added, also through affiliation by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad. From July 1, 2013, postgraduate studies in Sociology and Education were started, and from May 30, 2019, postgraduate courses in Hindi, Geography, Home Science, Urdu, education, sociology and Ancient History were also affiliated. Currently, this college is affiliated with Prof. Rajendra Singh (Rajju Bhayya) University, Prayagraj. The rapid growth from a school to a postgraduate college was not accidental but a result of firm determination and positive vision shared by the then Dean of the Faculty of Education at Allahabad University, Dr. Ram Shakal Pandey, and the Dean of the Faculty of Education at Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad, Dr. S.P.
